

## Arrival at Waterdrome

The Midnight Sun Fly In Association anticipates numerous arrivals of float, amphibious and wheel aircraft for the 2023 Midnight Sun Fly In. To assist with our preparations and facilitate your arrival, please review and follow the instructions below.

### 1 BEFORE DEPARTURE

Prior to departure, review the aircraft details and itinerary provided in your registration form. This information assists Fly In crew to plan for arrivals and allocate docking. Report changes to [midnightsunflyin@gmail.com](mailto:midnightsunflyin@gmail.com).

### 2 DOCK ASSIGNMENT

The Fly In aircraft parking coordinator will email pilots several days prior to the event to advise of assigned dock locations.

### 3 FILE FLIGHT PLAN

File a flight plan to Yellowknife (CYZF). The filing of a flight plan is prudent for safety reasons and assists NAV CANADA staff at the CYZF tower to anticipate arrivals.

### 4 CONTACT ATC ON APPROACH TO YELLOWKNIFE

Contact the CYZF tower on 118.5 at 15 NM from CYZF and advise that you are inbound to Back Bay or Yellowknife Bay for the Midnight Sun Fly In.

### 5 ACTIVATE STROBE LIGHT

Activate the strobe light on Pilot's Monument at 2 NM final (or 45 seconds prior to departure) by depressing mic 5 times on 119.5. The strobe alerts boaters that aircraft are arriving or departing the waterdrome.

### 6 LAND AT ASSIGNED LOCATION

Land on Back Bay or Yellowknife Bay. Both bays are subject to air traffic control but the CYZF tower does not have visual on either bay. Upon landing, report down and clear and close your flight plan.



### 7 CONTACT GROUND CREW FOR DOCKING INSTRUCTIONS

Monitor 123.2 for further instructions. Fly In crew will communicate with pilots on that frequency and provide taxi directions to dock locations where crew will be available to assist with docking.

### 8 TRANSPORTATION

Fly In crew will be operating a shuttle to provide transportation to your accommodation or the Fly In site. If the shuttle is not present on your arrival, local cabs can assist you.

### 9 REGISTRATION

Report to the registration desk at the Fly In site to confirm your arrival, finalize your registration, and receive your welcome package. The desk will be open during the Meet-and-Greet from 4:30 pm to 8 pm on Thursday.
